If I were in Italy, what I could be doing!

This past summer Michael and Sherri Carlson started their first English camp in Rome and continued English camps for a third year in Montefiascone (near Ronciglione). God blessed both camps and here are some of the results.

In Rome:

- The local church leader of this very evangelistic church said, "This was the best evangelization we ever did!" because it actually made positive contacts in their neighborhood.
- Believers from 2 or 3 additional Rome churches are interested in offering an English Course next year.
- Almost 30 Gospels of John, Italian evangelistic brochures, and English evangelistic books or booklets were given out to joyful students.

In Montefiascone:

- Nearly 70 students participated
- 10-12 students attended American-style praise and study times on the beach.
- Nearly 40 students requested a personal visit or literature to explain the evangelical faith (they're going to be busy for awhile!).

I look forward to helping organize English camps in future summers. Part of this responsibility will include working with American groups to help teach. Maybe you will be able to come and participate in one?

This is the first summer in 6 years that I have not spent at least part of the summer working for God in Europe. It has been a joy to reconnect with many of you and even meet new babies, spouses and make new friends. I am enjoying the refreshment, beauty and weather of CA. But... truthfully, my heart is longing to back on the mission field of Europe.

As I have talked with many of you, I realize there is some confusion on what I am doing now. I have two main objectives for my time in America. One is to reconnect with past supporters and connect with others who have an interest in reaching out to Italian youth. I have been contacting churches, mission boards and speaking with small groups. **Can you help me connect with your church or a small group?**

My second objective is to be fully prepared for long-term mission work in Italy. There are fewer Christian materials available in the Italian language than there are in Romanian. For this reason I am taking some graduate classes at BIOLA University in Intercultural Studies. I have been able to take all of the appropriate classes that are only offered in CA. Additional courses that will assist me can be taken in Europe, so I do not need to delay my departure because of schooling.

My position as youth director in Ronciglione is waiting for me and the ministry there continues to grow. The Carlsons are in need of additional staff as soon as possible! I am hopeful that my support will be in place so that I can leave for Italy in the spring of 2005.

Enclosed is my newly completed Italian brochure. Please pray about passing this on to someone who may be interested in joining our ministry team. I trust that God will use our efforts to make a difference in Italy.

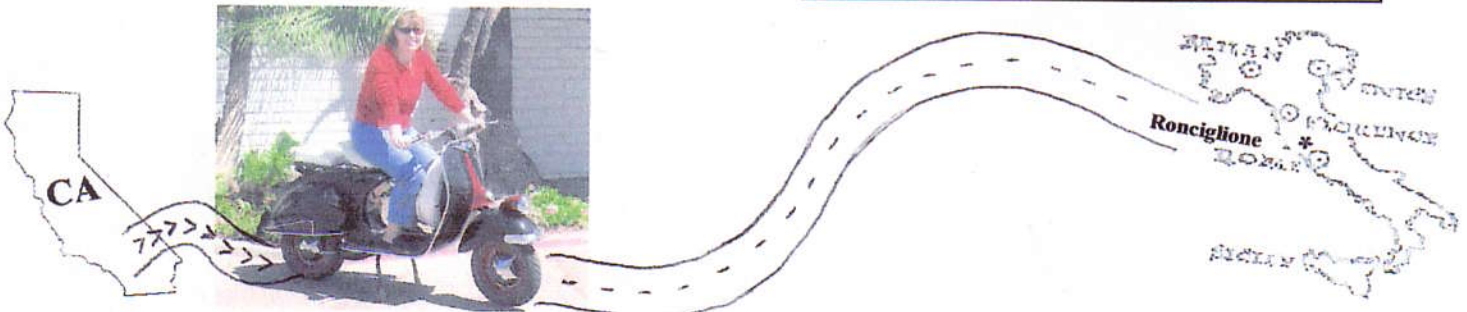
